

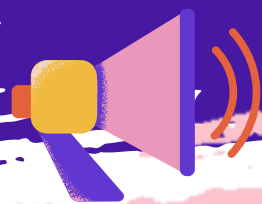
Calling all **young Business Brains!**

If you answered "YES!" and are aged 16 and under, read on to find out how you can get a spot in this year's Young Entrepreneurs' Village at the Binsted Fete.



Event Details...

Binsted Fete is taking place on Saturday 13th July 2024, from 1pm until 4pm on Binsted Recreation Ground. Access to set up your stall will be from 9am until midday. All cars must be off the fete field by midday.

A pitch in the Young Entrepreneurs' Village will cost £5 and will need to be paid to Alix Arrowsmith (the Stalls Co-ordinator) before the Fete opens at 1pm. This year we have 'Splat the Rat' and 'Tin Can Alley' equipment to hire for £10 (inc your pitch fee), email: info@binstedfete.co.uk as these are available on a first come, first served basis.

You will need to provide your own equipment including a 3x3m square (maximum size) weather suitable gazebo, table, signs, chairs, money float & prizes/ products for selling.

You are fully responsible for your goods, equipment and money at all times.







Things to think about...

The aim of Binsted Fete is to have fun, enjoy a great day out and celebrate our beautiful countryside and thriving community. With this in mind, here are a few tips when planning your stall...

Help us to make our fete as environmentally friendly as possible so please think about how you can ...



-  Cut down on plastic waste and single use items.
-  Swap plastic for natural or re-cycled alternatives.
-  Decorate your stall or sell items that are pre-loved, up-cycled or re-purposed.
-  Use re-cyclable or biodegradable goods and packaging..

Be original in your ideas! If you know a friend is planning a similar stall to you, why not join forces and share or come up with a Plan B? As spaces are limited, we will only accept one type of each stall in the Young Entrepreneurs' Village.

This is your business! Of course, do ask your parents to help when you need it, please don't disappear on the day and leave your mum or dad to run your stall for you. YOU will need to be on your stall from 1pm until at least 2.30pm to attract your customers. After that, you can stay open for as long as you like - we totally understand that you want to enjoy the Fete too and spend your hard-earned cash!
